<u>Geography</u> This term children will find out about:

The 4 countries in the UK and their capital cities

Name and locate the 7 continents

Name and locate the 5 oceans

PSHE- Money Matters

Throughout this topic we will explore:

What money is and how we can save and spend money.

The difference between needs and wants

Design Technology- Food

We will understand where food comes from and design, make and evaluate a sweet treat!

<u>Phonics</u>

Children will receive daily phonics lessons.

Year One and two will have separate sessions continuing to learn new sounds, read tricky words and learn spelling and grammar rules.

Science - Animals including humans

We will learn about the five senses and body parts.

We will learn about animal groups (reptiles, mammals, amphibians, birds and fish.)

<u>Computing</u> We will use data programmes and learn about E - safety

<u>RE</u> Our key questions for this term is 'Who is a Muslim and what do they believe?'

<u>PE</u> The children will have one PE lesson on a Thursday please send your child to school in their PE kit on this day.

Reading and Writing

<u>Reading-</u> We will read and explore a range of fiction and non-fiction texts linked to Arctic adventures. Children will be heard read one to one by an adult in school each week. There will be a weekly guided comprehension and guided reading lesson as well as whole class reading. Children will have opportunities throughout the week for reading for pleasure when selecting free choice books from our reading corner and we will share our favourite stories each day.

<u>**Grammar-**</u> We will continue to practice writing sentences containing capital letters and full stops. We will practice improving our vocabulary choices by using adjectives, verbs and nouns. We will learn about the past, present and future tenses.

<u>Writing</u>. We will write a non chronological report on Arctic animals, sequence stories and write alternative endings and explore poetry.

<u>Maths</u>

In math's this term we will be focussing on fluency and reasoning.

<u>Year One</u>

Our maths sessions will include:

Place value (within 50)

Money (recognising coins and notes and counting money)

Multiplication & division (making doubles, grouping and sharing)

Fractions (halves and quarters)

Time (o clock and half past)

<u>Year Two</u>

Our maths sessions wil include:

Addition and subtraction (bonds to 10 & 20, adding 2 digit numbers, subtracting 2 digit

numbers)

Money (making pounds and giving change)

Multiplication & division (doubling and halving, multiplying and dividing by 2 and 5)

Fractions (finding halves, quarters and thirds)

Time (telling the time to 5 minutes))
