We hope to be flexible with arrangements and offer a drop in service but initially we need to know how many to cater for. Payment is required upfront please for the first week. Payment will be required when booking for the first week back please. Thank you

If you have not returned your form and you would like an appointment, please contact Mrs Duric in the school office and we will do our best to accommodate you.
